- Call 705-949-2301, ext. 4444 to contact Security
- Call 911

WHERE TO START:

- Share with someone you trust. Let them know what you need.
- Seek medical care if you have concerns about injuries, STI's, pregnancy, or for forensic documentation. We can help you or accompany you to a healthcare provider.
- Contact the Student Services Advisor or a member of the Campus Response Team.

HOW WE HELP:

Survivors have access to our support regardless if the sexual violence happened on- or off-campus, or if you were subjected to sexual violence before you came to Algoma. With your consent, we can help you with:

- Safety planning
- Referrals to counselling and medical services
- Self-care resources
- Academic and workplace accommodations
- Understanding the reporting options available to you
- Navigating systems and resources within the university and the community

Every survivor addresses violence, accesses supports, and heals from trauma in different ways. Any way you choose to survive and feel safe is valid. We will support you on whatever path works best for you.
