

Out of Province Tuition Fee Deferral Request Form

INSTRUCTIONS

This form is for students receiving provincial loans/grants from another Canadian province or territory that wish to defer their tuition fee deposit until their funding arrives, and also are requesting an extension on tuition fee payment to allow for enough time for funding to arrive. Note that if your request is approved, the fees must still be paid, but at a later date. Once completed, submit to the Financial Aid & Awards Office by June 30 for processing.

IMPORTANT

- You will need to provide proof of funding in the form of an official notice of Assistance/Assessment from your province or territory that confirms your name, current study period dates, guaranteed funding amount that available as of the tuition fee deadline. In most cases this can be printed from their website.
- If approved, your tuition fee deposit will be collected once your provincial or territorial funding is available.
- If approved, Fall fees are due in full by September 30th and Winter fees by January 31st.
- If funding is delayed or you are reassessed and become ineligible for financial assistance, it is your responsibility to pay fees in full by the deadlines.
